Dear Captain Caulkin

I can confirm that the Maritime and Coastguard Agency (MCA) recognises the "regs4ships" and "regs4yachts" CD-ROM and/or Internet product as an electronic equivalent which meets the requirements of the Merchant Shipping (Safety of Navigation) Regulations 2002 in respect of the carriage of "M Notices" i.e. Merchant Shipping Notices (MSN), Marine Guidance Notes (MGN) and Marine Information Notes (MIN). However, vessels using the Internet version as their primary mode for access must also carry the 2 monthly CD-Rom as back-up.

This recognition is given on the basis that the M Notices are reproduced as published, in read-only format and the CD-Rom is the latest available from your company.

The MCA also recognises the above products as electronic equivalents for the onboard carriage of SOLAS, MARPOL and STCW and UK regulations when these publications are referenced within the Safety Management System documentation placed on board by the Company. This recognition is given on the basis that the UK regulations and IMO Conventions incorporate the latest available amendments.
